BAND BOOSTERS MEETING

Dena Jefferson called the meeting to order at 7:07 p.m. and introduced Mr. Ceresini.

Band Director's Report: Mr. Ceresini welcomed everyone to the freshmen orientation meeting. He mentioned that there are 11 different ensembles and approximately 185 students that participate. There are 99 people signed up for Marching Band so far, and 65 students signed up for the three jazz bands. He gave the dates of the three mini marching band camps and the mandatory dates in August.

Indoor Units start in November around the conclusion of the Marching Band season. This includes Drumline, Indoor Majorettes, Winter Indoor Guard. There will be an information meeting held in early November.

Mr. C. also explained the opportunities there are for all band students to audition for County & District bands, etc. We had two band students participate in the All State Band Festival in Erie this year.

A brief demonstration of CHARMS was given to show all the different ways it is utilized for all band students. Also showed where parents can volunteer for events.

Student Officers Report: Outgoing (graduated) President Janelle Koontz introduced newly elected President, Blake Milbrand & Vice President, Mitchell Loser.

Mitchell reported on the Jazz bands' recent events, the spring concert and the Knoebels picnic. The concert was great and he thanked the parents for all of the food.

Blake talked about the Concert Band & Wind Ensemble spring concert, one of his favorite songs they performed was Machu Pichu. The Marching Band had a great time at the Linglestown Memorial Day Parade, the weather was great, and no one passed out this year!

The Indoor Groups had a great season. They competed at Wildwood in May. Indoor Guard was promoted to a higher class. Percussion had its highest score yet, and placed 3rd in finals. Indoor Majorettes also received their highest score. All groups are now in A Class.

Blake and Mitchell thanked the Boosters for the Band Banquet that was held last Friday.

Incoming freshmen were dismissed at this time to go on a tour with current band students.

President's Report: Dena started her report letting new parents know that the Boosters support all of the band groups. Band Booster meetings are typically the first

Vice President's Report: Michelle gave the band website www.cdramband.org, and showed the calendar. Mr. Ceresini said that the calendar should be up to date through next June. It shows football games, parades, concerts, etc. Michelle also mentioned that the Booster officer names and e-mails are on the website and that anyone is free to contact any officer with questions or comments.

Recording Secretary's Report: The minutes taken by Laurie Kissinger (outgoing Rec. Secretary) were shown on the screen. We do not print copies, they are generally posted to the website within a week of the Booster meeting. Kathy Herring made a motion to approve the minutes and Missy Miller seconded.

Membership Committee: Kathy Herring explained the benefits of membership and had forms available to join. She also shared how personally rewarding it is to get involved.

Treasurer & Financial Secretary Report: Kelley Houtz handled presenting both of these reports and explained the set-up/layout of both reports. There are copies available at the Booster meetings each month. Missy Miller made a motion to accept the reports and Sugi Judd seconded.

Fundraising: Mr. Ceresini explained our various ways to raise funds and also emphasized that they are all **optional**. Some of the ways to earn money for your student account is to purchase Scrip, Herco & GTP volunteering at Hersheypark, sub sales, candy sales, etc. He also showed where the security box is for students to deposit payments, etc.

There will be a trip this year to Orlando, FL from 12/26-01/01 so it would be great to start earning money for your student account. The trip is open to students in any band at CDHS. Approximate cost of the trip will be \$900.

Upcoming Volunteer Needs: Dena explained what our needs are for uniform fittings, concession stand and Bake Table duties at Landis Field.

Scrip – Missy Miller explained how the program works and where the pick-up location is. The July dates will be different to coincide with Marching Band mini-camps. Stay posted for exact dates.

Golf-a-Rama – Kelley Houtz mentioned the time that was listed on the Agenda is incorrect, it should be 1:00 p.m. not Noon. They are still accepting golfers, even if you are not a golfer, just come out for a great dinner. Lots of great raffle prizes.

Legends of Music – Deb Hauf is still working out a date with the Glenn Miller Orchestra. It looks like their Sunday's are booked so it may be a Monday or Tuesday evening in September.
