Dena Jefferson called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Treasurer's Report: Kelley Houtz: Expenses this month were for CD gloves, Band-a-Rama start up money, transfers for trip payment. A \$36,000 check was written to Group Travel for the first trip payment. Checkbook balance is \$28,229.77

Recording Secretary's Report: Janice Mountain: The minutes were posted on the website. Tim Schultze made a motion to approve the minutes and Chris Mayer seconded. They were unanimously approved. Janice read a Thank you note that was received from Andy Herring thanking the Boosters for his scholarship award.
