### **MEETING MINUTES**

Tom Castanzo called the meeting to order at 7:32 p.m.

**Treasurer's Report: Ron Linville:** The big expense items this past month were the catering bill for the Band Banquet and the greens fees & food for Golf-a-Rama. The largest amount of income came in from Golf-a-Rama. Checkbook balance (general & student) is \$33,588.61. Michelle Chambers made a motion to accept the report and Deb Hauf seconded.

**Financial Secretary Report: Holly Zieber:** Deposits were from District Jazz, Scrip sales, Golf-a-Rama & Wearables. We also made \$3.37 interest on our account. Angie DiFlorio made a motion to accept the report and Scott Zieber seconded.

**Recording Secretary's Report: Janice Mountain:** The minutes were posted on the website. No correspondence to report. Michelle Chambers made a motion to approve the minutes and Ron Linville seconded.

**Vice President's Report: Michelle Chambers:** Volunteer opportunities for football games will be posted on Charms next week.

**Scott Zieber:** No report.

**Kristi Castanzo:** Business sponsorship letters were sent out. We have received \$950 so far. After July 31<sup>st</sup> a list will be posted for students to solicit business sponsorships. The profit is a 70/30 split with 70% going into the student account.
