



Meeting Minutes
Tuesday, September 6, 2011

Mr. Ceresini called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. He and Cathy Sangillo conducted the meeting as Diane was out of town with a family emergency.

Treasurer's Report: Cindy Case: There was approximately \$10,000 spent this month, the major expenses were for guard uniforms, flags, the pool party and band fair. The deposit for band fair will be on the Sept. report.

Financial Secretary's Report: Maki Traynor: She is entering the business sponsorships into the student accounts. If you notice a discrepancy please contact her.

Recording Secretary's Report: Laurie Kissinger: The minutes are posted online in the week following the meeting. A motion to approve the minutes from last month was made by Janice Mountain, and seconded by Michelle Chambers. They were approved by a unanimous vote.

Vice President's Report: Cathy Sangillo: No report.

Student Officer's Report: Emily Longenecker and Emily Mountain: The officer's were happy to be giving their first officer's report and commented that they have been friends since elementary school. They reported that band camp was a success, but a grueling two weeks. The Jazz band has already had their first gig, playing for the teachers first day. Discount Book: The kids will be bringing them home tomorrow. They sell for \$25 with a \$12.50 profit. This will be a 70/30 split between student account and boosters. The orders will be due Monday Sept. 19th.

Aarogas night: The vouchers are available on the web site. They are good at any location, but the back room at the route 22 location has been reserved @ 6:00 if band families want to gather there.

GTP/HERCO: There are currently only 5 band families that participate in this program. Hershey posts new shifts at the beginning of the month they pay 5.85/hour and a voucher for the park. 70% of this goes into your student account. Call or email Barby Warfield with any questions. Barby reminded the group that if you sign up for a shift, you must cover it, or find someone else if you can't do it. Family members are welcome to participate; you must be 18 to work.

Presidio Brass: We have currently sold approximately 100 tickets. Rich had posters available to distribute. There will be an upcoming ad in the Paxton Herald and the Patriot News. The Ramada Inn has donated 5 rooms to house the group.

Military Band: We currently have a request in to the Marine Band to come in the spring.

Wolfgang Candy: The sale will be in mid-November, with the orders delivered in time for Christmas. The brochures will be available at the November meeting.

Sub sale: The order forms are available on the website. They are from R&K subs and this is an easy fundraiser, with \$1.58 profit from subs, and \$1.40 from Kaisers for your student accounts.

Audit: This is currently underway.

New Business:
