



Meeting Minutes
January 2, 2013

President Diane Baker called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Treasurer's Report: Cindy Case: This month the report shows a deposit of \$3291, and then a withdrawal in that amount. There is an issue with the check we received for hosting the Showcase. Mr. C. and Cindy are working on this. We recently paid the truck rental for the Marching Band season; this will be reimbursed by the district.

Concert Bands: Playing evaluations and seating are being done. They are trying to use Charms system, but there are some technical issues and they won't play for him. He is working on this issue. County Band auditions are January 9th.

Indoor Groups: They are all rehearsing; the first shows are January 26.

Jazz Band: Coming up is Chocolate fest on Super Bowl Sunday, it is earlier this year and they should be home around 2:30.

Craft Show: We have received 160 applications so far. The date for this is March 23, this is our biggest fundraiser, and is an all hands on deck event. The volunteer sign ups will be on Charms, we really need everyone to help out!

Legends of Music: Deb Hauf has begun researching Military Bands availability.

Indoorama: There are 34 groups signed up so far. This is another huge event where we will need lots of volunteers! The biggest need at this time is for someone to take over coordination of the kitchen. The bulk of the fundraising for this event comes from food sales and we will have a lot of hungry participants and parents. We cannot have the show without the kitchen!
