



Meeting Minutes  
February 5, 2013

The meeting was called to order at 6:59pm.

**Treasurer's Report: Cindy Case:** There were a lot of deposits this month from the craft show, over \$10,000. We now have over \$16,000 in the general account. The expenses this month were for Wish List items, fall staff gifts, and indoor expenses.

**Financial Secretary's Report: Maki Traynor:** The previously bounced check from the Showcase adjudication has been straightened out, and the \$3,000 was deposited in our account.
