To all parents and students of indoor groups and other helpers (including ALL band booster members):

Now is the time to sign up to help at our Indoor Show scheduled for March 15th at noon. The Charms software is somewhat limiting so this will give detail on the jobs we have listed, especially for parents new to indoor. We really encourage students to sign up as well. Feel free to sign up for more than one shift. **We need lots of help!** We do not yet know the performance schedule, but we will make every effort to free you up to watch your student perform if you are working. If it's not clear, the numbers after each job on Charms are the time slots.

Food checkout cashier: Capable students can sign up for this as well as adults. You may want to bring a calculator!

Grams table: We sell airgrams, candygrams and flower grams. Spectators purchase these for us to give to the performing students.

Grams Table Runner: Work with the Grams table to deliver the purchases to the units. Students can sign up for this.

Gym Doors: The performing units take a specific route when they come in and out of the gym. The unit entrance mans the door to tell the group when it's time to come in. You'll be told how to know when that is. The exit just opens the door. Both entrance and exit are also to be sure no one else comes through those doors during the performance. The spectator entrance is closed during performances and opened again between each one. At times this job requires some crowd control!

Kitchen: We will not be doing any of the cooking ourselves; the cafeteria staff does this. We put it in serving containers and dispense the food. Early and late shifts will set up/ clean up as well. It is required that you wear closed toe shoes.

Parking Lot: There is a specific direction for units and spectators to drive and park, so you'll direct them outside. There will be signs as well. We hope to have members of the football team helping with this, but anyone else is welcome to sign up.

Tickets: Sell tickets at the spectator entrance near the cafeteria.

Unit check in table: Greet and instruct the units as they arrive, guiding them to their practice areas. Show chair will be there most of the day, but could use some help.

Unloading dock door: Just opening the door as units unload equipment. Bring a book or a buddy!

Macaroni and Cheese: We will provide you with a foil pan to fill with your favorite homemade recipe of macaroni and cheese. Please bring it hot and ready to be served to the cafeteria by 11 a.m. on the morning of the show.

Raffle: Sell raffle tickets by the spectator entrance.

Baked Goods (no peanut products): No sign up necessary, just bring individually wrapped items ready to be sold for 50 cents each to the cafeteria by 11am on the day of the show OR to the school office with Mr. Carraher's name on it on Friday the 14th.
