Craft Show Report

Just wanted to say a great big "Thank You" to all who helped with the craft show in any capacity. We had so many compliments on our students and volunteers.

It was a successful day in many ways. The weather was perfect for bringing out the shoppers and I saw many people buying and many crafters were happy with their sales. Some weren't, of course!

We had a few interesting things that happened.

1. On our way in on Saturday morning we noticed that someone had stolen our directional signs that we had just put out the night before, as well as all of the signs that were along Piketown Road.
2. Before the show started, I got a call from a crafter who was crying. She had just gotten off of Interstate 81 and her car shut off. She really wanted to come to the show, so Roger Koontz went and got her and her crafts and she was set up in time for the show to start. Roger took her back to her car and the tow truck driver after the show. I called her later that evening, the tow truck driver had dropped her off safely at her home.
3. Chef Tim offended the poor crafter beside his space and people stood in line in front of her space for his free samples. She did not have a successful day. I refunded her space fee and gave her an Aleve. Chef Tim will not be invited back because he left the show early. His excuse was that he "did not have any more samples to offer".
