Band-a-Rama: Tom Castanzo: He thanked everyone that helped to make this a successful event. We made a profit of \$2,226.16. We need someone to coordinate this for next year.

Chaperones: Holly Zieber: We could use two more people to push equipment for this Friday. We also need more help for October 30th, Senior night.

Buddy Night: Tom Castanzo: Since Buddy Night was postponed due to bad weather there has been discussion between our director and the middle school directors as to when to re-schedule. They feel that the best time to have it would be in conjunction with the Keynotes Concert and have an ice cream social time afterward. A few people expressed concern that the middle school students would not get the same feeling playing in an auditorium versus having the Friday night Landis Field experience with the football game atmosphere. It was asked why we couldn't hold it at our home game October 23rd against Cumberland Valley. Tom will communicate these comments to Mr. Carraher and they will let everyone know when Buddy Night is re-scheduled.
