### **MEETING MINUTES**

Metro Bank is changing to First National Bank and they require a minimum balance in non-profit accounts. We will close out one of the trip accounts and just keep one open. Checkbook balance (general & student) is \$48,999.40.

The indoor group won their first competition with a score of 72. Things are going very well. Next competition is at Lower Dauphin on February 27<sup>th</sup>.

76'ers Trip is on March 20<sup>th</sup>. The cost is \$25. We will play on the concourse before the game. The game is a 6:00 tip-off time. Only students may ride the buses.

**Executive Board: Recording Secretary:** After last month's Booster meeting Dianne Rhine said that she would be interested in the position for next year. Michelle Chambers made a motion to nominate her and we will vote at the March meeting.

**Judges Clinic: Tom Castanzo:** This is the 3<sup>rd</sup> year that we hosted. We provided breakfast and had lunch items for sale. They reimbursed us for the breakfast items and gave us an additional \$250 donation. Thank you to everyone that helped out. We made a profit of \$419.

**Perkins Dine to Donate:** We had 63 people there the 1<sup>st</sup> night and 71 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> night. We earned \$611.70 and the manager rounded it up to \$750.

**Sandwich Sale: Janice Mountain:** We sold 165 subs and 267 pretzel sandwiches and made a profit of \$797.25 with 60% going to the student accounts. After Janice described the process of this fundraiser, Cheryl Koury agreed to take this on for next year.

**Candy Sale: Lisa Fox:** Orders and payment are due on February 11<sup>th</sup>. Delivery will be the week before Easter.

**Craft Show: Michelle Chambers:** We have already deposited over \$11,000 in crafter space reservations. Volunteer spots are posted on Charms along with descriptions of what the different jobs are. She is still looking for someone to shadow her since her son will be a senior next year.

**Indoor Rama: Kristi Castanzo:** Planning is underway. There are 44 units registered. We need someone to manage parking from 10:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. She would like to have 2 people to work at

the volunteer table, they answer questions, hand out name tags, ice packs, etc. Volunteer spots are now on Charms. Shifts are available from 8:00 a.m. – 9:30 p.m. We will also need donations of taco meat, mac & cheese and bake sale items. The raffle item this year is an Apple watch. Tickets are \$5 each, sell by March 22<sup>nd</sup>.

**Uniform Coordinator – Lori Goldmann:** She has a packet that is an overview of responsibilities. This will be her last summer so she would love for someone to work with her to see the whole process from beginning to end. Some responsibilities are: organizing uniforms, fitting, entering information into Charms, and arranging cleaning and storage of uniforms.
