MEETING MINUTES

Dena Jefferson called the meeting to order at 7:32 p.m.

Treasurer's Report: Kelley Houtz: The big expense items this past month were \$1,800 in scholarship awards, Staff gifts, and senior blankets (Stitch Art). Checkbook balance is \$42,092.53. On June 1st two checks for \$4,500 each were paid to Choir & Orchestra for Music in the Parks. Kristi Castanzo made a motion to accept the report and Deb Hauf seconded.

Financial Secretary Report: Holly Zieber: There wasn't a lot of activity this past month, a few expense transfers. A \$13,500 deposit from Music in the Parks and then \$9,000 came out on June 1st to pay Choir & Orchestra. Lori Goldmann made a motion to accept the report and Tim Schultze seconded.

Recording Secretary's Report: Janice Mountain: The minutes were posted on the website. No correspondence to report. Michelle Chambers made a motion to approve the minutes and Scott Zieber seconded.

Vice President's Report: Michelle Chambers: No report.

Scott Zieber: He was encouraged by the number of people that attended the orientation meeting.

Tom Castanzo: No report.

Student Officer Report: Pres: Michael Schultze: His time at CD is coming to an end, he thanked everyone for all of their support the last 4 years both personally and as a band member, and for awarding him the Whit Gingrich scholarship.

Band/Locker Room Clean-up: We will be meeting here on June 10th at 10:00 a.m. for clean up and organization of the band room and locker room areas. Stop in and help if you are able.

Chaperones for Football Season: Holly & Scott Zieber: Mr. Carraher reported that effective July 1st every volunteer must submit background checks. A full policy will be e-mailed out from the school district. If we do not have record of these clearances, individuals will not be able to chaperone or volunteer in a capacity where they are in direct contact with students. Concession stand workers will not have to do them if that is the only place they volunteer. The cost of the two state background checks are \$20 combined. The FBI fingerprint check is \$35, however, you are exempt if you have lived in PA for the last 10 years, but you must sign a waiver form. There is still discussion as to who will be keeping these records. They will have to be re-done every 3 years.

Sandwich Fundraiser: Janice Mountain: Forms will be distributed at the 2nd mini-camp in July and orders will be due the first week of Band Camp in August with delivery the second week of Band Camp.

Business Sponsorships: Kristi Castanzo: Six hundred letters were sent out on May 29th. We have received 3 \$50 sponsorships so far. We will accept them until the end of July and then she will give names of businesses to students to solicit.

Pigskin Preview 9/02: Angie DiFlorio: We will need volunteers to work concessions, bake table, and grill food items. This will be the first public performance of the Marching Band show.
