Blake reported that the concert bands are busy preparing for their concerts in November. The percussionists are going over to Messiah College for a clinic. Marching Band competition season has begun. The stand & play show at Red Land went well (had to be moved indoors due to rain). The show at Wilson last Saturday was amazing, they received a score of 85 and were named the best at the show. Mr. Carraher had a talk with the students before practice tonight about stand behavior. Blake and Mitchell thanked the Band Boosters for the many things that they do for the students in giving of their time and donations.
