



Meeting Minutes

Tuesday, February 7, 2012@7:00pm

Treasurer's Report: Cindy Case: January was a quiet month. There was approximately \$7,000 moved from student accounts for trip payments. About 5% of participants have not yet completed trip payments, which are now past due. We will begin making phone calls to contact these people.

Financial Secretary's Report: Maki Traynor: Maki has been posting trip payments, as well as an \$800 re-imbusement from the school district for the Altoona trip.

Vice President's Report: Cathy Sangillo: No report.

Recording Secretary's Report: Laurie Kissinger. The minutes from last month's meeting are posted online. They were approved by Dena Jefferson, and seconded by Michelle Kauffman. They were approved by a unanimous vote.

Student Officer's Report: Emily Longenecker: Emily was joined by Andrew Fazenbaker who reported on his experience with the All American Marching Band. The US Army selects the top marching musicians from across the country. This year there were 125 members who participated in a show at the US Army Bowl in San Antonio, Texas. Andrew reported that it was an awesome experience and everyone was very driven and focused. Emily reported that District Jazz auditions were held, and the Jazz bands participated in Chocolatefest and had a great time. She also enjoyed the recent school board meeting where the Marching Band was recognized along with the State Champion football team.

He was very pleased with how all the groups played at the winter concert, and has begun playing evaluations in the classroom this week. Andy Herring was selected for Regional Band.
