



Meeting Minutes
Tuesday April 3, 2012
7:00pm

Mr. Ceresini called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Treasurer's Report: Cindy Case: This month we spent a lot, and took in a lot! The expenses were for the baskets(fundraiser), staff gifts for Marching Band, Scrip cards for purchase(since GL Scrip is closed), subs, and next years Marching Band Show. The deposits were for the uniform campaign and the craft show. We opened a second trip account for the Wildwood payments, as the Orlando trip money is not yet finalized.

Financial Secretary's Report: Maki Traynor: She reported that some more expenses for the craft show may still be coming in.

Recording Secretary's Report: Laurie Kissinger: The minutes from last month were posted online. They were approved by Janice Mountain, and seconded by Dena Jefferson. They were approved by a unanimous vote.

Vice Presidents report: Cathy Sangillo: Cathy was absent, no report.

Student Officers: Emily Longenecker and Emily Mountain: There was a lot of activity this past month. They heard that the trip was fun for those involved. The Jazz Pops concert was a lot of fun. The craft show was a huge success. They reported that the Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band, and Jazz Bands all have performances coming up.

Band Directors Report: Mr. Ceresini: Mr. C. introduced his student teacher who will be with him until early May. He also reported that the trip was successful with great performances and fun with friends. A professor from Messiah College came to the school to work with the concert bands, and will be coming back next week. He is a "musical genius" and it was very exciting to have him here.

The Indoor program is in full swing, and all three groups are doing very well this year.

Mr. C. gave thanks to all for the Craft Show efforts-this is a great community event!

Upcoming events: May 1st is the spring Band concert. Jazz I has the "prison gig" on April 11-this is playing for the Dauphin County Prison Volunteers dinner, and The Central PA friends of Jazz event-they are opening for Kim Thompson (Beyonce's drummer) on April 22. This will be at 5:00pm at the Harrisburg/Hershey Sheraton.

The kids have been measured for the new Marching Band Uniforms!! He appreciates all the hard work going into this campaign.

Old Business:

Scrip: There will be no scrip order tonight, Great Lakes is closed for the week. Missy has Giant, Weis, and Karns cards available. We are doing well with the program, and Missy reported that we will keep the 50/50 split for next year.

Orlando: We are almost done with the finances for the trip. There are several more reimbursements that need to be take care of. At OrlandoFest the concert band received a superior rating as was awarded Grand Champion. The Jazz Band received a superior rating, and the Choirs received a Superior rating and were Grand Champions. Please remind your student that if they went on the trip they need to pick up their t-shirts in the Band Room.

Sub Sale: The total profit was \$1751.50 with a 70/30 split. The money is being credited to student accounts.

Craft Show: All we can say is WOW! We are showing a \$14,302 profit! We brought in \$645 on the crafters raffle, and \$490 in donations and ipad raffle tickets for the uniform campaign. Some extra thanks go to Melissa Graeff for advertising, Shannon McLeod for the program, Monica Riddle for sweeping the entire gym and hallway, and Dena, Michelle, and Sugi did a great job in their first year of learning the ropes.

Indoorama: This is a big fundraiser and performance day for our program. We still need lots of volunteers, please sign up on Charms!

Band Banquet: The caterer and DJ are set. The student historians will be working on the slide show and will need senior pics/baby pics from the graduating class. The invites will go out for the banquet in late April. The boosters pay for students, parents and siblings will need to buy tickets. Mr. C. needs the scholarship applications done ASAP!

Uniform Campaign: We have received \$15,000 in true donations, the program is continuing. We will possibly do another restaurant night at Perkins in April. The TE connectivity match continues, if you know anyone who works there that would donate, the company will match the funds. We are in good shape for the down payment, but we need to raise enough to pay them off by mid August. The Ipad raffle continues, we have sold \$1500 in ticket sales. The raffle will be April 21, all sold tickets, unused tickets, and money need to be returned by then.

BandaRama: The date is set for October 6th. LeeAnn Stewart has agreed to join the committee, we are still looking for a few underclassmen parents to join as the committee members will all be senior parents.

GolfaRama: The date will be Friday June 22 at 1:30pm at Deer Valley Golf Club. Stay tuned for more info.

Legends of Music: We are still looking for someone to chair this event!

Basket Sale: We have sold 10 baskets so far, Laurie still has 30 in her living room to sell! The order form is available on the website.

GTP/HERCO: There will be shifts opening up soon.

Knoebels: The date is May 19th. All Band families are invited. The Jazz students will be performing, and they will ride the bus and get free wrist bands. Everyone brings food to share for the picnic. See you there!

New Business
