MEETING MINUTES

Dena Jefferson called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. She explained the various forms and when they are due and where students should place them. Mr. C. and Kathy Herring also explained how Mr. Bob's Subway order forms work for home football games, etc.

Student President & VP Report: Blake Milbrand & Mitchell Loser: Blake reported that they are trying to move and play the 1st song of the show and they are making good progress considering it is only Day 2 of Band Camp. Mitchell said that they are doing great on drill. They are half way through the 1st song. Morale is really good, and they are looking forward to Service Day this Friday. In conjunction with service day, Blake is doing a food drive for his senior project. He will be collecting food items from each section of marching band, a pizza party or something special will be provided for the group that donates the highest percentage from their section. The donations will be taken to the Food Bank on Friday.

Treasurer's Report: Kelley Houtz: Several large checks were written this month for the shed, DCI tickets, Wildwood truck rentals, and to Menchey Music for a new bassoon. Total deposits were \$6,771 and withdrawals were \$10,715.43.

Financial Secretary Report: Holly Zieber: She reported that she used the old format for the report but is thinking of doing a two page report to make the print larger and easier to read. She still has some deposits to post. The Perkins check has not been deposited yet.

Recording Secretary's Report: Janice Mountain: The minutes were posted on the website. Michelle Chambers made a motion to approve the minutes and Holly Zieber seconded. They were approved by a unanimous vote.

Vice President's Report: Michelle Chambers: She reported that there are currently 10 different events on Charms under the Volunteer section ready to be filled. Any questions on how to volunteer through Charms, e-mail or call her. **Scott Zieber:** No report.

Band Director's Report: Mr. Ceresini shared that he has accepted a Band & Orchestra director position with Great Valley High School in Malvern, PA.:(He said that it is very bittersweet and his leaving is no reflection on his time at CD. The staff, kids, and parents have been wonderful. He and

his wife have wanted to move closer to their parents. His position here at CD was posted yesterday and they are hoping to fill it as soon as possible.

Mini-camp went very well as far as learning. Musically and educationally it was a much better way to prepare for Band Camp. If we continue with the mini-camp format, the dates will be posted in late fall for vacation planning, etc. Service Day is this Friday and we need 2 parent volunteers to go along.

Parent night is August 15th. Marching band students should wear polo shirts and khakis. The picture for the football program will be taken that evening.

There will be marching band practice sessions on 8/20 & 8/22 from 6 - 9 p.m. A few Saturday practices will be announced later.

Band Fair will be held on 8/28 beginning at 5:30 p.m. Concession will be open and we are looking for volunteers. We will not be running the game portion of Band Fair this year since attendance and participation were low the last few years.

Jazz I rehearsal is 8/19. Mr. Bitner may run this if needed.

OLD BUSINESS

Scrip: Missy Miller: This is the first month of the fiscal year. We are back to the regular order schedule and an order goes in tonight. Weis Markets is now on the Great Lakes Scrip list, they only come in \$25 or \$100 denominations.

Band-a-Rama: LeeAnn Stewart wasn't present but she let Dena know that we have 3 bands confirmed, CD East, Halifax, & Steel-High. Mr. C. has been in touch with a college band.

Business Sponsorships: The letters were mailed out and some sponsors are starting to trickle in. The good news is that we have some new sponsors already for this year.

Landis Field Concessions: We staff the Visitor side concession area for the whole game. There are volunteer slots on Charms for the different shifts. We also have a bake table so we need delicious goodies individually sized/wrapped to be sold for 50 cents (no peanut products). Dena also explained that Chef Tim feeds the marching band kids during their 3rd quarter break.

GTP/Herco: Contact Cheryl Martin if you are interested in working a shift. There are some openings for food concessions and ushering.

Event Coordinators: We still need someone to coordinate the SKH Fall sale, Kelley was able to secure the date of October 5th. We need baked good donations, soup, chili, etc.

Melissa Baer volunteered to handle Buddy Night for the 2014/2015 season.

Band Trip: The band will perform at Disney World. There will be an educational opportunity for guard and band members.

Membership: Kathy Herring played the video that her son Andy made showing the advantages of joining the Band Boosters. The video is on the band website as well. Memberships have been slow coming in so far.

Chaperones: Sugi Judd & Holly & Scott Zieber: They handed out a Chaperone interest form this evening with all the Marching Band events. This form is also on the website. We need to have 6 chaperones for football games and 8 at competitions. They explained what the duties of a chaperone consist of. Sugi also explained that you do not need a CDL to drive the truck but she did warn that it does have air brakes.

Sandwich Sale: Orders are due 8/7 and delivery will be on 8/14. There is a 70/30 split of the profit with 70% going in the student account.

Perkin's Restaurant Nights: We had a total of 97 people there on July 24th, and approximately 40 on July 25th. We received a check for \$1,200.

Uniform Fittings: We fitted all but 5 kids during the mini-camp. We do need volunteers to iron cuffs and hems. If you are interested, contact Michelle Chambers.

Band Shed: This was an idea from the graduating class of 2011. They donated a portion of the money as their senior gift and the Boosters paid the rest. Loysville Structures gave us a nice discount because we are a non-profit organization, and Nye's gave us a discount on the stone. We need a little ramp that is moveable and some shelves for inside the shed. It will be great to store the podiums, yard markers, cases of water, etc. out at the parking lot.

Legends of Music: On hold for now.

Buddy Night: September 20th. May include 7th graders this year.

Mentors: Kathy Herring: Twelve families volunteered to be mentors. They tried to match instruments but were not always able to do so.

New Business

Landis Field Concession Changes: Scott Zieber reported that the CD Alumni Association will no longer be working at the Home side concession stand. The cheerleaders will now staff that concession area. We will still work on the Visitor side concession area. We will now get 1/3 of the profit instead of 20%.
