MEETING MINUTES

Dena Jefferson called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Treasurer's Report: Kelley Houtz: We had more deposits than expenses this past month. There were deposits of \$16,000 and withdrawals of \$3,000.

Financial Secretary Report: Holly is absent so Dena presented her report.

Recording Secretary's Report: Janice Mountain: The minutes were posted on the website. Michelle Chambers made a motion to approve the minutes and Tom Castanzo seconded. They were unanimously approved.

Vice President's Report: Michelle Chambers: No report.

Student Officer's Report: Pres. – Michael Schultz & VP – Johnna McGreevy:

Michael reported that the parade went well and it was nice that the weather was a little cooler than previous years. Knoebel's was a nice way to end the school year for the jazz bands. The band banquet was very nice and the slide show was well done. Graduation went well but pomp & circumstance got a bit stale.

Band Director's Report: Mr. Carraher: Graduation went very well. Parade was great and we were done in 35 minutes. Wind Ensemble and Jazz I received music to practice over the summer. The first marching band mini-camp is June 16-19 from 6 – 9 p.m. The two mini-camps in July will be 4 – 9 p.m. Remind students to wear sneakers and bring sunscreen & plenty of water.

Mr. Bitner: Jazz Ensembles & Solaris concert on May 16th went very well. Knoebel's was a great day and the weather was beautiful. There will be a short rehearsal for Jazz I the Monday before school starts. He will be asking the Band Boosters for money to purchase pizza.

OLD BUSINESS

Scrip: Missy Miller: Missy was not present. For June, July, & August there will be one order per month. June 17th, July 8th, August 5th. PrestoPay or ScripNow can be done anytime.

GTP/HERCO: Cheryl Martin: They will need ushers for the Big 33 football game and upcoming week-end concerts.

Band Banquet: Melissa Baer: Things went well and she thanked everyone that helped. It seemed that everyone liked the new format of starting in the auditorium and finishing with dinner.

Band-a-Rama 9/13/14: LeeAnn Stewart: We have 13 bands registered, still looking for a college band. A planning meeting will be scheduled.

Golf-a-Rama: Kelley Houtz & Tom Castanzo: Would like to get two more foursomes to play. We currently have 13 groups signed up. If you get a hole-in-one on Hole 10 you win a 1 year lease on a new Buick.

Legends of Music: We are hoping to get the Glenn Miller Orchestra to come in November or December to do their holiday concert.

Knoebels - May 17th: The performances were well attended and there was lots of food. Thanks to the Loser & Nicholas families for planning & hosting this event the last few years. The Chambers & Mayer families have agreed to chair this event for next year.

Coordinators Still Needed: We still need someone to coordinate a fall event at SKH. Sugi Judd said she would call and reserve a date for us and hope that this summer someone steps forward to organize it. It is easier to cancel a reserved date than it would be to fit a date in the SKH and our schedule later on.

Also need someone to take soda & water over to Landis Field for our band students at home football games. The Hollenbecks have done this the last few years as well as the bake table. Sugi Judd has volunteered to handle the Bake Table at the 5 home games this year.

Budget: Wearables income was reduced to \$500, Equipment & Repairs expense was reduced to \$1,000. Also under Expenses Special Events, Military Band will need to be changed to Legends of Music. Sugi made a motion to accept the budget as presented, Michelle Kauffman seconded. Unanimous vote to approve.

Trip Update: The cost will be \$900, includes transportation on Executive bus line, tip for drivers, lodging, 2 meals a day (breakfast @ hotel, voucher for meal in parks), entrance fees to the parks. We will be leaving on April 1st @ 5 p.m. and will arrive at the park Thursday morning before checking in to the hotel later. We will leave Sunday evening to head home. A monthly payment schedule will be September thru January. Price is based on 200 people.

Copier: Mr. Carraher let us know that they are looking into purchasing or leasing a new copier for the Music Department. Ideally it would be nice to have one that does two-sided copying, and that you need a code to use, that way each area of the Music Department would get charged for what they use. If anyone has any suggestions, please let him know.
