### **MEETING MINUTES**

Dena Jefferson called the meeting to order at 7:32 p.m.

**Treasurer's Report: Kelley Houtz:** There was much less activity this month. Deposits of \$3,400 and withdrawals of \$4,200.

**Financial Secretary Report: Holly Zieber:** There was an increase of 5 more Business sponsorships since last month. The SKH sale made \$710 less \$424 in expenses. We will have some income from event ticket sales also.

**Recording Secretary's Report: Janice Mountain:** The minutes were posted on the website. Tim Schultz made a motion to approve the minutes and Michelle Chambers. They were approved by a unanimous vote.

**Vice President's Report: Michelle Chambers:** She is sending around a sign-up sheet for concession stand volunteers for Friday night's play-off game.

**Scott Zieber:** No report.

**Student Officer's Report:** Vice President, Mitchell Loser gave the report since President, Blake Milbrand is working at the election polls this evening. Mitchell said that indoor begins practice next week and that this is their only Tuesday night off. Wind Ensemble has their first concert this Thursday. The freshmen band concert went well. The jazz bands are working on their Christmas music.

**Band Director's Report: Mr. Carraher:** Marching Band season is done. The game vs. CD East was the first normal half-time show that we got to play. Hempfield will do the half-time show this Friday. After this Friday, we won't perform the show anymore, just do stand tunes. Our marching band got promoted at the ACC show, this means we will compete against 37 other bands instead of just one. The show design and staff roles will change for next season. The Group 4 championships will be on 11/3/14 at Hersheypark Stadium.

Jazz Bands are getting ready for their December events. The 9<sup>th</sup> grade concert went very well.

**Mr. Bitner:** The Jazz 1 gig at Mini-thon overlaps with the Harrisburg Parade, may have to cancel or re-schedule mini-thon performance.

## **OLD BUSINESS**

**Business Sponsorships:** Nothing new to report. We need a chairperson for next year.

**Membership:** Kathy Herring reported that we have 62 members. They put the forms out at the Keynotes concert and at the Freshmen concert last week.

**GTP/Herco:** Contact Cheryl Martin if you are interested in working a shift. They were looking for people to be survey takers at hockey games.

**Legends of Music: Deb Hauf:** Right now there are 530 tickets reserved. There is a veterans' ceremony at Fort Indiantown Gap the same day at 2:00 so she feels that some of those folks won't be available to attend our concert. Doors open at 2:00. They are asking for baked good donations, package them the same as for a football game.

**Holiday Candy Sale: Michelle Kauffman:** Orders are due tonight. She will accept orders until this Friday. Delivery will be at the December booster meeting.

**Landis Field Concessions:** No one was present to give a report. Dena thanked everyone that helped this season and reminded everyone that they still need volunteers and baked good donations for the play-off game this Friday.

**IRS Return:** It is due November 15<sup>th</sup>. Cindy Case is working on it and Andrew McNaughton volunteered to do the audit.

**Senior Night: Mindy Schutte:** She reported that the football boosters sent out a bio survey as well to the senior students for the program. There needs to be better communication between the 3 groups so that everyone knows what their responsibilities are. The cheerleader boosters weren't happy about paying for all of the flowers. Someone suggested that maybe each group should pay for their flowers. Another suggestion Mindy said was to restrict each senior to only having two people

accompany them onto the field to help with the crowding and congestion of getting everyone lined up. Another parent said that she felt it wouldn't be fair to make the kids choose just two people because some of them have two households and it would put the kid in a difficult position. Next year there needs to be better communication between the 3 groups well in advance of Senior Night.

### **New Business**

**Trip Information:** Mr. Carraher reported that we are waiting to hear from the Phillies about playing at a game.

There is a Concert Festival in Washington D.C. from May 23<sup>rd</sup> - 26<sup>th</sup>. It is the 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration of D-Day. The trip will be open to all band students. Cost is \$430 if we have 50-55 students go, includes 2 nights lodging (4 per room), 2 meals per day, entrance to the National Symphony and Memorial Day Parade. Possibly participate in the wreath changing ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Tim Schultz mentioned that if we attend that ceremony, boys need to wear ties and girls would need to wear dresses. If the trip is approved by the school board we would need a deposit by the next Booster meeting.

**Sandwich Sale:** Orders are due 11/25 and delivery will be on 12/3 between 2:30 and 5:30 p.m. 70% of the profit goes into the student account.

**Indoor Rama:** Kelley Houtz reported that the kickoff meeting is November 18<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. The Penn State Indoor Drumline will be at Indoor Rama on March 15<sup>th</sup>.

**TIA Judge Clinic:** Mr. Carraher reported that we are hosting the judges' clinic on January 11<sup>th</sup> at CD Middle School. We need to provide breakfast items and some lunch options that they can purchase. We need someone to handle the food. Deb Hauf volunteered to take care of the breakfast items. Tim Schultz volunteered to help cook for lunch. We will need cashiers for lunch time. There will be approximately between 200 - 250 people attending this clinic. Please be in contact with Dena if you are interested in helping with this. Janice Mountain mentioned that if we will be using any of the stoves or ovens at CD Middle we are required by the district to hire a cafeteria employee since volunteers are not permitted to use the kitchen equipment.

**Craft Show: Michelle Chambers:** The show is on April 5<sup>th</sup> and we usually make \$11,000 - \$12,000 profit. We will have 209 spaces this year with each space being larger this year. Our return rate of crafters is 75%. We need someone to handle the raffle this year since we now have a small games of chance license. Linda Topp & Deb Hauf volunteered to do the raffle sales. We also need someone to manage the distribution of the road signs that are placed in the community to advertise the craft

show. Please contact Michelle if you are interested. There will be a meeting scheduled for Craft Show chairpersons and anyone interested in helping is welcome to attend.
